

# Version 6.10.4

The price list information is divided into a total of 11 files. When the files are delivered, all files must be merged into one ZIP file. All files in the ZIP file are mandatory for delivery.

## File names in the ZIP file

## Definition of the file name of the ZIP file

The name of the ZIP file is defined as follows:

Manufacturer-code-manufacturer-subcode-language-version-country-code-valid-from-version.zip

Example: HLD-IGA-DE-DE-20040401-1.zip

The version is simply a consecutive counter and starts at 1. If there is no manufacturer subcode, this code is omitted. Example: HLD-DE-DE-20040401-1.zip

The indicator for the language version is defined according to "ISO 639-1 Alpha-2". See also [http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/ISO\\_639](http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/ISO_639)

The country code is defined in two digits according to "ISO 3166-1 ALPHA-2". See also [http://de.wikipedia.org/wiki/ISO\\_3166\\_Kodierliste](http://de.wikipedia.org/wiki/ISO_3166_Kodierliste)

## Manufacturer-specific files

It may be the case that the existing definition is not sufficient to represent the delivery options for a specific delivery program of a manufacturer. In this case, it is possible to integrate manufacturer-specific data formats.

However, no manufacturer-specific files are currently defined.
